WHAT: E³ is a school-wide initiative new to Crofton Elementary this year. This program utilizes school personnel, parents, and community partners to provide interest-based educational clubs to students during the school day. HOW: All students K-5 will complete an interest survey and determine which clubs are right for them.
